**9 – 10:15 am – Wkshp 1: Getting' Jiggy with It!** – basic dulcimer techniques and strumming rhythms for playing Celtic jigs.

**10:30 – 11:45 am – Wkshp 2: Crossing Over to the Fun Side.** This workshop gently guides players to leave the security of playing the melody on one string to explore the world of cross-picking. In addition to some work with scales and hitting individual strings, we'll learn to cross-pick some familiar songs effectively and efficiently.
